Pet Licenses

Don't forget that ANY pets 6 months or older need to be licensed annually. Spayed/neutered is \$5.00, and non-spayed/unneutered is \$10.00. Please also bring in a copy of your pet's updated rabies vaccinations.

Volunteers are needed. Please call or stop by the City office if you are able to volunteer. You will need to sign a waiver. If we don't get enough volunteers, we CANNOT have the cleanup.

Acceptable items: Bulky household items. **Non-acceptable items:** Electronics, such as TV's, computers and monitors, printers, and household hazardous waste, lawn mowers containing fuel or liquids, liquids of any type, Freon containing items such as refrigerators and microwaves, propane tanks, gas cans, cement blocks, masonry bricks, or any other type of landscape support, tires, household remodeling material.

Note: Any item(s) deemed to be a hazard to the driver or helper or the collection vehicle, will not be collected.
