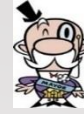

## **Pet Licenses**

**City Office has 2017 Tags NOW!**

ANY pet 6 months and older needs to be licensed annually (Renewal Jan. 1st every year) Spayed/Neutered is \$5.00 Non-Spayed/Unneutered is \$10.00. Please bring in a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccinations.

Please respect the plows. Do not attempt to snow blow until plows have left your street. For your safety and ours. Sincerely, Public Works

## **Ordinance Reminders**

\*Unlawful to move, dump, or deposit snow or ice onto public streets. **\$500 Fine** [5-02-02.2]

\*No parking on snow emergency routes during snow emergencies. **May be immediately removed!** [8-03-03 & 13-13-14]

\*Unlawful to park or leave vehicles, campers, boats, trailers, etc. on the street consecutively, longer than 48hours. [13-13-10]

Notes: Mailboxes are resident responsibility. If your box is in a cluster, help your neighbor out.

If your **phone number** has changed, please let the city office know so we can **update** your utility billing. We use these contact numbers in the case of **emergencies**. ~Thanks

Drop Boxes: For your convenience, there is a double gray drop box in front of the City Building at 74 Santee Rd. This box is secure and checked daily. The upper slot is for your City Water Bill, Pet License, Police Fines etc. and the lower one is for MDU bills. Please do not place Capital Electric bills in either the city drop box or the MDU drop box. There is a Capital Electric drop box at Dakota Community Bank. Using the wrong box may result in your payment never reaching them.
