## **COUNCIL CORNER**

Just a few things that need addressing going on around town, First, Millennium Park should be done by the end of July and seeded in the Fall. The contractors are concerned about high ground water and are trying to save the city money by letting the soil dry instead of pumping water out when they install the drain tile. Second, I've had a lot of complaints about people going door to door selling things and trying to enter people's residences. If you have a person come to your door please ask to see there permit from the City of Lincoln if they don't produce one Call the Police, ASAP! So far, the Police Department has chased out three unpermitted people. Finally, as we're all aware we have water restrictions going on, the reason is due to the prolonged elevated temperatures, lack of rain and the large amount of summer water use. The levels in our water tower get dangerously low and will provide NO fire protection in case of emergency. The City has been and will continue to consider other avenues for additional water sources to help maintain safe water levels.

### **Ordinance Updates Effective**

**June 8, 2017**

Violation of the animal running at large  
ordinance will result in a \$50 fine

Dangerous animal at large will result in a  
\$500 fine

Noisy Animal- Any Disturbing noise audible  
to a person within an enclosed building  
located on a neighboring property is  
sufficient to constitute loud. Any disturbing  
noise lasting for a period of 30 min or longer  
constitutes frequent – violation of this  
ordinance will result in a \$50 fine

## **BURN BAN**

Burleigh County has declared a Fire  
Emergency and instituted a Burn Ban  
effective June 9 thru October 1, 2017. The  
area is under abnormally dry conditions. The  
burn ban (to include a ban on garbage/pit  
burning, campfires, and burning of farm or  
crop land) remains in effect when the North  
Dakota Rangeland Fire Danger Rating is  
"High", "Very High", "Extreme", and/or a Red  
Flag Warning has been issued.

**THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS BURN  
BAN IS A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR (NDCC 37-  
17.1-10.1: MAXIMUM SENTENCE OF 30 DAYS  
IN JAIL AND \$1,500 FINE).**
