Burleigh only got approved from 66th Street all the way down to Benteen. Burleigh with the project will only take care of the surface water and not the ground water. The land that the water is draining into the Corp of Engineers stated that it is Wetlands. It is not the cities responsibilities for the natural drainage into the wetlands. Fischer did have a hydraulic map and reports showing where the drainage was going into the wetlands. After great discussion a researching of grants to fix water issues will be researched.
